## Launch/Haul-Out Waiver & Request (This form must be completed for each Launch/Haul-Out)

## A few reminders to make the launch/haul out successful for us all...

We ask all boat owners (or their representative) to be present at the time of your launch/haul. Your boat must be unlocked prior to your booking; dock lines and fenders **must** be placed in your boat in full view and be easily accessible to the Yard staff.

Please ensure that all work is complete (by owner or private contractor) and that the boat is ready and safe for launch. Water readiness (i.e. sea cocks closed, lines and fenders ready) is to be confirmed **by the owner**. Inspect your cradle to ensure that **it is safe**. Yard staff reserves the right to refuse a launch/haul if your cradle is deemed unfit, but responsibility for water readiness and safety of the cradle rests solely with the owner.

The Yard staff books all dates for launches/haul-outs in consultation with the Marine Services Manager and in conjunction with the scheduling of other vessels waiting to be launch/hauled. We ask all boat owners (or their representative) to be on time for their scheduled launch/haul-out. In the event the owner (or their representative) is not on time, the launch will normally proceed unless previously notified otherwise by the owner (or their representative).

2) All people using AYC's premises, facilities including and all floats, ramps and other equipment and devices and the equipment of Owner's/Member's do so at their own risk and AYC assumes no responsibility whatsoever for any damages, loss or injury to the Member/Owner and their property and any damages, loss or injury to the Member's/Owner's invitees and their property; and				
3) All vehicles parked on AYC's premises and the contents therein are left at the vehicle owner's risk.
