

# Notice of Race Mark MacNeil Memorial Race June 25, 2022

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021- 2024.
- 1.2 Handicap fleet boats shall compete with equipment that is compliant with their PHRF-NS certificate.

# 2. Sailing Instructions

#### 3. Communication

- 3.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

#### 4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the PHRF-NS Handicap class that are registered with Sail Nova Scotia on their website.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form at AYC before the race or hailing AYC Race Committee on VHF 71.

# 7. Class Splits and Sails

- 7.1 Handicap yachts shall have a valid PHRF-NS rating listed on the Sail Nova Scotia yacht database. Boats not listed on this database will be given a provisional handicap. Boats not listed on the Sail Nova Scotia yacht database shall give at least one week notice of intent to compete so that a handicap can be assigned. This provisional handicap cannot be contested during the course of the event.
- 7.2 Boats wishing to race without a spinnaker shall declare as such at time of registration.

## 8. Course

- 8.1 Courses shall be made up of marks on the Sail Nova Scotia Course Card (2021). All classes will use the same start/finish lines.
- 8.2 The course will be determined on the day of racing and indicated to competitors at the Skippers' Meeting.

# 9. Scoring

- 9.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no drops).
