

# Notice of Race AYC Commodore's Cup August 27-28, 2022

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024*.
- 1.2 Handicap fleet boats shall compete with equipment that is compliant with their PHRF-NS certificate.

## 2. Sailing Instructions

#### 3. Communication

- 3.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

## 4. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all members of Armdale Yacht Club boats with a valid PHRF-NS handicap.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form at AYC before the race.
- 3.3 One keelboat class for this event.

#### 5. Fees

# 7. Handicaps and Class Splits

- 7.1 Handicap yachts shall have a valid PHRF-NS rating listed on the Sail Nova Scotia yacht database. Boats not listed on this database will be given a provisional handicap. Boats not listed on the Sail Nova Scotia yacht database shall give at least one week notice of intent to compete so that a handicap can be assigned. This provisional handicap cannot be contested during the course of the event.
- 7.2 Boats wishing to race without a spinnaker shall declare as such at time of registration. Those boats shall be placed in classes based on their non-spinnaker handicap.

#### 8. Course

8.1 Courses shall be made up of marks included on the new Sail Nova Scotia Course Card (2021). All fleets will use the same start/finish lines.

8.2 The course will be determined on the day of racing and indicated to competitors at the Skippers' Meeting.

# 9. Scoring

- 9.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no drops).
- 9.3 Ties will be broken and the winner determined by the boat with the lower elapsed corrected time.
