

Notice of Race Fall One Design Weekend August 27-28, 2022

1. Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021- 2024.
- 1.2 Handicap fleet boats shall compete with equipment that is compliant with their PHRF-NS certificate.

2. Sailing Instructions

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the AYC website (http://www.armdaleyachtclub.ns.ca/events) and at registration.

3. Communication

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at (http://www.armdaleyachtclub.ns.ca/events.
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Roue, Bluenose, and Soling one design classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form at AYC before the race.

7. Class Splits and Sails

- 7.1 Boats will sail within their designated class.
- 7.2 The Bluenose fleet is white sail only.
- 7.3 The Roue fleet is permitted to use spinnakers.
- 7.4 The Soling fleet is white sail only.

8. Course

- 8.1 Courses shall be made up of marks included on the Evening Race Course Card or the Sail Nova Scotia Course Card (2021). All classes will use the same start/finish lines.
- 8.2 The course will be determined on the day of racing and indicated to competitors at the Skippers' Meeting.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 Each fleet is anticipated to have 3-5 races per day (depending on wind and weather conditions)
- 9.2 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no drops) if there are 1-4 races. A boat's series score will be the total of her lowest race scores, with one drop, if there are 5 or more races.
